CLINIC RULES, RESTRICTIONS & REQUIREMENTS

- All pets must be in good health and friendly (able to be handled by staff)
- All pets must be brought in by legal owner, and at least 18 years old
- Puppies/kittens must weigh at least 3 lbs., and be at least 16 weeks of age
- No pets over 55 lbs.
- Pets must be between the ages of 4 months and 6 years
 - (Pets over 7 require bloodwork & IV catheter- at an additional cost to pet owner)
- All Dogs must be on a leash
- **Cats must be in a carrier (only one cat per carrier, please)**- This is for post-surgery recovery reasons.
- **Do not feed your pet after 10:00 pm the night before, water is allowed**
- **A \$30 non-refundable deposit per pet, is required at time of registration by credit/debit card**
 - The deposit will cover the cost of take-home post-surgery pain medication/inj. & e-collar.
 - This process was implemented due to the high rate of no-shows for these events/specials.

Additional Vaccination & Services - Offered to Surgery Patients Only - Microchip \$10

- Parvo/Distemper combo, Bordetella Vaccine (canine) and FVRCP (feline) \$15 each
- Nail Trim \$5 - while pet is under anesthesia
